#### 1. Roll Call

President Bill Casey opened the public hearing on the proposed 2014 PARC grant proposal for renovations at the Glenview Park Golf Club, located at 800 Shermer Road, Glenview, IL, at 7:04 p.m. and the Roll was called.

#### 2. Public Comment

President Casey stated that the purpose of tonight's public hearing is to review the specific components of the proposed application for funds from the State of Illinois' 2014 PARC grant program.

The Park District is proposing renovations at the Glenview Park Golf Club to include: renovation of all tees, greens and fairways including grassing, grading and drainage, rebuilding of all sand traps including drainage, shaping and minor relocation, construction of 17.5 acre feet of storm water retention/detention including the addition of one lake and expansion of another on hole #7, the installation of a network of piping and depressional areas to collect water on course and away from areas of play, and reconstruction of the parking lot and extension of cart paths.

It is further proposed that the Park District apply for funding with the State of Illinois' PARC grant program in the amount of \$1,100,000 in matching funds for these improvements.

President Casey asked if there were any comments from the public and there were none.

3. **Adjourn**

With there being no further comments, President Casey asked for a motion to adjourn the public hearing.

Commissioner Przybylo moved seconded by Commissioner Peterson to adjourn the Public Hearing at 7:06 p.m. On Voice Vote, all present voted aye. Motion Carried.
