**1. Roll Call**

President Bill Casey called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. and the roll was called.

**2. Public Comment on FY 2013/2014 Budget and Appropriations Ordinance**

President Casey commented that the purpose of tonight's public hearing is to explain the purpose of the Budget and Appropriations Ordinance and to obtain any comments on it. He noted that the ordinance has been available for public inspection at the Park District's administration office since May 28, 2013 and notice of the public hearing was published in the June 20th edition of the Glenview Announcements.

President Casey explained that the Budget and Appropriation Ordinance is a required filing that sets the legal maximum that can be spent in specific line items within each fund if sufficient funds were available. This means that any possible expense needs to be anticipated and included as part of the Budget and Appropriations Ordinance. Otherwise, if unanticipated funds, such as grant funds or donations, became available, the District would not be able to use them as intended without additional legal filings.

President Casey went on to explain that the Budget and Appropriations ordinance should not be confused with the park district budget or the tax levy. At the December 20, 2012 Board meeting, the Board approved the tax levy ordinance which requested the amount of taxes needed to fund the park district during the 2013-2014 fiscal year.

The BAO which will be under consideration tonight sets the legal ceiling for spending above and beyond what was planned in the budget, if unexpected circumstances arise or additional funding becomes available.

This year, the appropriation is set at \$123,325,000 with a budget of \$32,611,520.

President Casey then opened the meeting up for public comments.

**3. Adjourn**

With there being no public comments, President Casey asked for a motion to adjourn the Public Hearing and noted action on this Ordinance would take place at the regular Board meeting which would follow this public meeting.

Commissioner Przybylo moved seconded by Commissioner Patton to adjourn this Public Hearing at 7:05 p.m. On Voice Vote: All present voted aye. Motion carried.

The following action on the proposed FY2013/2014 Budget and Appropriations Ordinance No. 2013-18, listed as a Consent Agenda item, was taken during the June 27, 2013 Glenview Park District Regular Board meeting which followed this public hearing. The Regular Park Board meeting was held in room 101 at Park Center, 2400 Chestnut Avenue, Glenview, IL (Same room as the public meeting)

Commissioner Przybylo moved seconded by Commissioner Peterson to approve the Consent Agenda items with minor edits to agenda item 8.c. as presented. Roll Call Vote: Ayes: Coulson, Patton, Peterson, Przybylo, Tosh, Casey. Nays: None. Motion Carried.
