



**Glenview Park District
Regular Park Board Meeting
June 25, 2015**

HIGHLIGHTS

The Board of Park Commissioners...

- Approved the May 28, 2015 Regular Board Meeting minutes which closed out the 2014/2015 fiscal year and the Reconvened Board Meeting minutes commencing the 2015/2016 fiscal year.
- Accepted the June 9, 2015 Recreation, Museum & Swimming Pools Committee meeting minutes.
- Accepted the June 16, 2015 Finance Committee meeting minutes.
- Recognized nine year old Glenview resident and Glenview Prairie Club member Effie Perakis who competed in the PGA “Drive, Chip and Putt” contest at Augusta National in April and captured the Girls 8-10 year old title by sinking a 30 foot putt on the 18th hole. The Board President presented Effie with a letter of recognition and congratulated her on this outstanding achievement.
- Approved Resolution No. 2015-15: Recognition of Superintendent of Leisure Services Bob Quill on his retirement: June 30, 2015. The Board thanked Bob Quill for his 42 plus years of service to the Glenview Park District and community. (Resolution attached).
- Approved Payroll and Accounts Payable for the month of May, 2015 in the amount of \$3,918,835.57.
- Approved Ordinance 2015-16 Prevailing Wage. It is a requirement that all public entities adopt a Prevailing Wage Ordinance every year in June. The Prevailing Wage Act requires that laborers, workers, mechanics employed by or on behalf of the District engaged in construction or demolition of public works to be paid not less than the general prevailing rate of hourly wages for work of a similar character on public works in the community in which the work is performed.
- Approved Ordinance 2015-17: Liquidation of Personal Property. This is a housekeeping item to sell unneeded Park District equipment.
- Approved Resolution 2015-18: Glenview State Bank Safe Deposit Box. This is an annual housekeeping item.

- Approved a Recreation, Museum, & Swimming Pools Committee recommendation to use funds from The Grove fund balance and to approve the base bid of \$145,000.00 from Action One Construction, Chicago, IL for the Grove Archives Building Expansion. Funds will be reimbursed when Museum Grant funding previously approved for this project is reinstated by the State of Illinois.
 - Approved Staff to submit a State of Illinois Open Space Land Acquisition & Development/Federal Land & Water Conservation Fund grant application.
 - Accepted a Recreation, Museum & Swimming Pools Committee recommendation to approve the bid from Malcor Roofing of Montgomery, IL in the amount of \$30,000 for interim roof repairs to the Splash Landings roof. The bid opening for this project was held on Monday, June 22 with four companies submitting bids.
 - Accepted a Staff recommendation to approve the 2015/2016 Annual Recommendations for the Glenview Ice Center.
 - Accepted a Staff recommendation to approve the bid from Sports Interiors, Inc., Prairie View, IL in the amount of \$29,540 to replace the backdrop and divider curtains at the Glenview Tennis Club. Only two companies submitted bids for this project which were opened on June 11, 2015.

RESOLUTION 2015-15

A Resolution Honoring Bob Quill for his contributions to the Glenview Park District while serving as an employee from June 1973 through June 2015

WHEREAS, Bob Quill began his career with the Glenview Park District in June 1973 as a 15-year-old part time locker room attendant. Upon graduating from Western Illinois University in 1979, he dedicated his entire career in the field of Parks and Recreation to the Glenview Park District, including managing the outdoor pools, the Glenview Ice Center, Rugen Community Center, and ending his career as Superintendent of Leisure Services; and

WHEREAS, Bob Quill helped establish the Glenview Park Foundation in 1996 to provide additional financial support to the park district in its delivery of recreation opportunities for Glenview residents. The Foundation has successfully raised over \$2.3 million which has been used to build five playgrounds, recast Glenview's Jackman Bear statue, provide community grants, help fund the construction of the Wagner Farm Heritage Center, and renovate the Willow Park Fieldhouse for use by children and adults with disabilities; and

WHEREAS, Bob Quill has been a champion of the park district's Leisureship program, partnering with Glenview State Bank and Youth Services of Glenview/Northbrook so that every child can participate in park district programs, regardless of their family's financial situation; and

WHEREAS, Bob Quill led the planning and execution of Glenview's 4th of July parade and fireworks show for over 30 years, creating a tradition and memories for thousands of Glenview residents; and

WHEREAS, Bob Quill played a key role in developing strategies for two successful community referenda that led to the acquisition and development of Community Park West and Wagner Farm and the construction of the new Flick and Roosevelt Aquatic Complexes; and

WHEREAS, Bob Quill was instrumental in the planning and construction of Park Center following the closure of Glenview Naval Air Station and led the 2012 expansion of Park Center's Health & Fitness Center to fulfill the needs of current and future users; and

WHEREAS, Bob Quill led the renovation of the 80-year-old Administration building in 2013, saving this historic structure that previously served as Glenview's Village Hall and Library by transforming it into a state-of-the-art facility that is able to serve the community now and in the future; and

WHEREAS, Bob Quill served as the project leader for the \$1.9 million renovation of the Glenview Park Golf Course in partnership with the Village of Glenview to improve the course's playability and aid in storm water management; and

WHEREAS, because of Bob Quill's leadership, the Glenview Park District has been recognized by the Illinois Park and Recreation Association for numerous capital improvement projects including Best New Facility Awards for Park Center, the Heritage Center at Historic Wagner Farm and Flick Pool and Best Renovation Award for Roosevelt Pool, accomplishments that promote community pride and have contributed to making Glenview a great place to live and raise a family; and

WHEREAS, Bob Quill cultivated numerous cooperative agreements with local government agencies, businesses and community organizations to provide quality recreation facilities and programs; and

WHEREAS, Bob Quill received the 2010 Jim Berousek Distinguished Alumnus Award from the Western Illinois University Recreation, Park and Tourism program in recognition of his high professional standards, strong work ethic, reliability, vision and commitment to the field.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT, AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, that the Glenview Park Board of Park Commissioners recognizes and thanks Bob Quill for his 42 years of dedicated service to the Glenview Park District and for his contributions, commitment, devotion and integrity in all matters on behalf of our community.
