Dear Glenview Park Golf Club Neighbor:

Spring is here! And with it comes renewed golf course work. We have been working on the course for the past few weeks, finishing up work started last July. As you may have seen, the course is beginning to green-up again and while there is still a long way to go before we can re-open for play, things are really beginning to take shape. Here are a few areas we will be working on over the next several weeks.

- Addressing drainage issues on the south side of hole 7, west side of hole 13 and east side of hole 15. These areas have been inspected by the architect and engineer and we will be working on these areas as soon as drawings are completed.
- Fertilizing and over-seeding of many areas to prepare the course for play later this summer.
- Planting over 200 trees and shrubs throughout the course (from mid-May to mid-June)
- Parking lot and driveway area restoration.

We have arranged for the North Shore Mosquito Abatement District to treat our wetland areas beginning in May. Once these areas have grown in with wetland plants and prairie grasses, this will no longer be necessary.

More exciting news: On April 1, work began on a complete renovation of the clubhouse. The project includes; a redesigned pro-shop, restaurant/banquet space and a major upgrade to the bathroom and locker room areas. Improvements to the front porch will also be completed prior to re-opening the course.

Finally, we ask that you continue to assist us by staying off the course and reporting any trespassing you may witness to the Glenview Police Department. Unauthorized entry and use of the course for any purpose could cause the opening of the facility to be delayed. We appreciate your assistance as we work to complete this critical course improvement and storm-water management project.
