

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Here are some great tips to keep organized as your skater prepares for the show.....

- 1. Check your child's name on the Ice Show skater list in the Glenview Ice Center lobby & make sure his/her name is spelled correctly. If not, contact Dorie Cascio at 224-521-2041 with corrections by April 5.
- 2. As you review this packet, **highlight your important information** such as rehearsal & show dates/times, and ticket information.
- 3. Complete and send in any forms (such as video order form or volunteer form) to the Glenview Ice Center by May 3rd
- 4. Carpool whenever possible.
- 5. Make sure your skater has his/her skate guards with their name in permanent marker guard at all rehearsals and shows, they must wear them!!!!

The Ice Show is a wonderful experience, but it does take a significant commitment for both parents and skaters. Your child will participate in approximately 2 to 5 rehearsals and 2 shows. Please take the time to read the attached information and to organize your family calendar accordingly. Full Dress Rehearsal Information

The dress rehearsal is "closed" to spectators (including dressing room volunteers). Your cooperation and patience while waiting is greatly appreciated.

Full Dress Rehearsal Schedule:

Friday, May 3

First half skaters arrive by 4:15 pm Second Half skaters arrive by 5:15pm

ALL skaters are to be in costume and must enter through their assigned stage doors and use their dressing rooms.

Skaters are to be dropped off to and picked up from their dressing room for Friday's closed dress rehearsal.

For all rehearsals, the groups will be led to the ice by a staff member or parent volunteer when it is their turn to skate, and then will be led back to the bleachers or dressing rooms when they're done.

Because this is the run-through of the entire show, we cannot predict how long it will last and ask that you please be patient while waiting for your child. We will be rehearsing the Grand Finale for the first time between the 2 halves and may need to run through it several times. SOLOISTS: refer to your soloist packet for your detailed instructions.

Parents of skaters 6 years old and under may stay in their skater's dressing room if it's not uncomfortably crowded. Otherwise, parents (except dressing room volunteers who MUST remain IN the dressing rooms) must wait in the lobby or return after an hour or so to pick up their skater(s) from the dressing room(s).

SKATERS MUST WEAR SKATE GUARDS TO REHEARSALS AND SHOWS!!!

Dressing Room Assignments for Rehearsals & Shows

For all rehearsals, the groups will be led to the ice by a staff member or parent volunteer when it is their turn to skate and then will be led back to the bleachers or dressing rooms when they're done.

SKATERS <u>MUST</u> WEAR SKATE GUARDS TO REHEARSALS AND SHOWS!!!

Costume Information

Costumes and Appearance:

Costumes are distributed in a week prior to the show during group rehearsals. Kathy Brickman will be on hand to describe how it should be worn and any finishing touches to be made. Here are a few things to remember about your costumes:

- Please refrain from eating or drinking while in costume (except water) at dress rehearsal or shows.
- If **ANY** part of the costume is missing, (boot covers, headpiece, etc.) the skater cannot be permitted to skate in that show.
- At show time, skaters should stay out of the lobby while in costumes. If the skater must go into the lobby, he/she should be covered by a long garment (such as a robe).
- For the safety of all skaters, skaters with long hair should wear it tied back in a ponytail, braid or bun. Please, no hair extensions & no jewelry should be worn with the costume.
- To prevent panty lines, girls should not wear underpants with their costumes.

Purchasing Tights & Other Costume Parts:

Costumes do not include tights EXCEPT Snowplow Sam and Basic 1-2. These have been pre ordered. Parents should purchase tights (for girls only) if they are required by the costume style.

Parents should purchase Mondor Performance TIGHTS. Tights will generally cost between \$17 and \$19. (Be sure to check the Mondor Sizing Chart so you purchase the right size for your skater and consider buying an extra pair just in case!) Tights can be purchased at **Offensive Zone** (the pro shop is located in the lobby of the rink)

NO OVER-THE-BOOT TIGHTS PLEASE! Skaters who come dressed in over-the-boot tights will be expected to cut or remove them before taking the ice for dress rehearsals and shows.

 the GIC Box Office in limited quantities. These seats will be located on the main floor by the rink
 doors so attendees should dress warmly.

BACKSTAGE PARENT VOLUNTEER INFORMATION

Each year we ask for all parents to volunteer to help coordinate and supervise the skaters backstage in the dressing rooms during shows and full rehearsals. A pass will be issued to the volunteer for the show in which they are working. Parent volunteers are crucial to the success of the show and the safety of the skaters. We truly rely on parents to help us out in this area.

All parents will be asked to volunteer one night, please fill out the form below and submit it to the office by **Friday, April 26**.

As a backstage volunteer during the tech/dress rehearsals and shows, please remain in your assigned dressing room the entire time the skaters are present, until the last skater has been claimed by his/her parent. Skaters performing in the first half (except Snowplow Sam and Basic 1-2) will be in their dressing rooms for the entire show, while skaters in the second half will be in their dressing rooms from their arrival time until the end of the show. This is because all skaters will be performing in the Grand Finale at the end of the show! This means that a ticket should not be purchased for show at which you'll be volunteering. Parents will be assigned to the same dressing room as their child. Volunteer Coordinator Kathy Brickman will call you with your Volunteer Assignment. Please do not wear open toed shoes in the dressing rooms!

Ice Show Photography & Video Options

Professional Photography:

Group & individual photographs will be taken for the 2019 Ice Show . . .

Krphotogs Photography will be here to take posed group and individual portraits of ice show skaters. Individual and group shots will be taken for all groups **except** Synchro Teams, Ice Crew, Opening #, FS1 & UP, Production #'s and the Soloist #. All other groups will be led by staff from their dressing rooms to the studio rink for **group shots**, before or after they skate **during the Full Dress rehearsal**, **Friday**, **May 3**. When all group shots are done, the skaters will be led back to their dressing room. At the conclusion of the dress rehearsal, skater may return to the Studio Rink to pose for individual shots. The photographer will stay until 7:30 pm to make sure every skater has the opportunity to have an individual shot taken. Proofs will be available for viewing at Krphotogs Photography web site in approximately 1 week after the show.

They will also take action photos during two of the ice shows. You may purchase all or some of the images from group and solo numbers, individual digital files or prints will also be available from the web site. More information will be available during the ice show.

Professional Videography:

ArtFX Video is filming the Saturday and Sunday shows. Please complete the attached form to pre-order a DVD(s) of the show. DVDs will be available 20-25 min. after each performance.

SPECIAL NOTE TO VIDEOTAPERS:

If you video the show with your own camera, please note that no outlets or power sources will be available and you will need to provide your own source. Please refer to the last page of this packet for information on ordering professionally recorded videos of the shows.
